



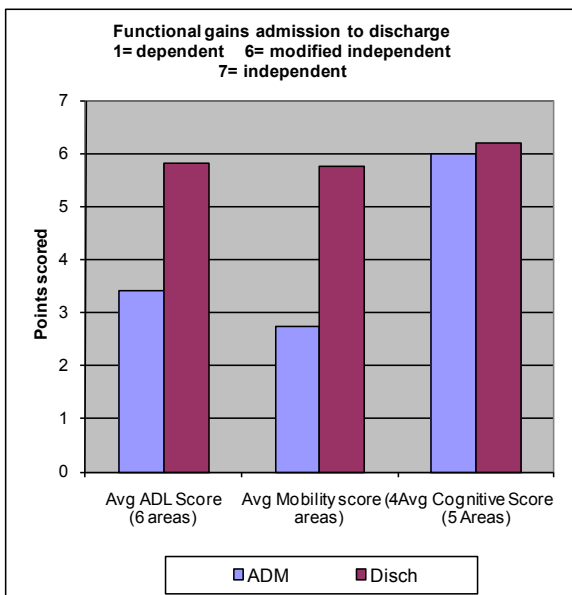
Another Northeast Rehab success story from Lawrence General...

Ms. Giarrouso was admitted to Northeast Rehab on 6/24/2011 requiring assistance with her Activities of Daily Living and ambulation.

When first admitted she was short of breath, tired easily, had issues with pain and was only able to walk short distances. After a customized program of OT and PT she is ambulating 125 feet with a walker free of pain and no longer experiences shortness of breath. Ms. Giarrouso also noted that it was very convenient for her to receive her dialysis treatment right on-site at NRH rather than having to be transferred for her treatment which often tired her when staying at other facilities.

After discharge from Lawrence General, Ms. Giarrouso spent time in two other skilled facilities before coming to NRH and immediately noticed that we provide a more rigorous therapy schedule accompanied by a terrific sense of teamwork among staff. This patient's hard work helped her make steady progress since her admission and she will be going home independently.
