## Specialty services for people in need of rehabilitation following a neurological event

I=Available for Inpatients O=Available for Outpatients H=Available via Home Care Services

### Bioness NESS® H200® and L300™ (I, O)

State of the art devices which use electrical stimulation to improve upper and lower extremity function.

### LSVT® Loud (I, O) and Big (O)

Speech and movement therapies for people diagnosed with Parkinson Disease and related neurological diagnoses.

### Lite Gait® (I, O)

Evidence based partial weight bearing gait therapy equipment for adults and children.

### Digital Modified Barium Swallow (I, O)

Digital fluoroscopy is used to diagnose and treat oropharyngeal dysphagia. This test looks at swallowing from the mouth through the pharynx.

### Spasticity/dystonia Mgmt. (Botox, Baclofen) (I, O)

A comprehensive approach may include: physical therapy, orthotics, pharmacotherapy. (Patients with cervical dystonia, focal limb dystonias, blepharospasm, and hemifacial spasm are also seen for Botulinum toxin therapy in this clinic). Intrathecal baclofen trials and post-pump implant management are available.

### Pain Management Services (I, O)

Two full-service pain management clinics staffed by anesthesiologists and clinicians specializing in pain management.

### Neuropsychological Screening (I, O)

Consists of a computer-assisted battery of memory, attentional and other tests. The patient is also administered a personality assessment inventory and in some cases as indicated, an effort test is performed.

### Vision Clinic (I)

The clinic is conducted by an optometrist, who specializes in vision problems caused by neurological conditions such as stroke or brain injury.

### Northeast Passage (I, O)

A program that transitions individuals to home and the community through recreational resource training and access to adaptive recreational equipment.

### Animal Facilitated Therapy (I, O)

Specially trained dogs are used to assist patients with goals related to endurance, cognition, and attention.

### Pediatrics Programs (O)

Full service outpatient physical, occupational and speech therapies for children from birth through age 18. Includes many specialty programs such as Arena Assessment Clinic, MDA clinic, summer camp and more.
